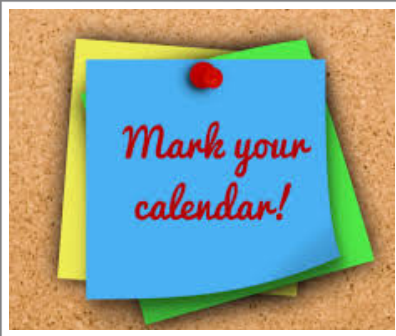
Vacation Bible School
