Vacation Bible School

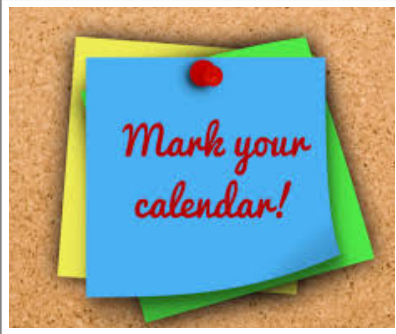
Sign up today!
