## How Do I Start?



Welcome to day 18 of our 21 days of prayer and fasting! As we approach the end of our fast I want us all start praying for the leadership at our church. This means staff, children's workers, production volunteers, worship leaders, choir members, deacons, trustees, committee members, greeters, kitchen staff, D-Group leaders, and anyone else who takes on responsibility at our church. Pray for those who are currently filling those roles and pray for those who God is calling to lead us in the future. What have we learned during our study about leadership? Power, strength, influence, heritage, experience, and wisdom all pale in comparison to faith and obedience. Above all, we need people who trust God and follow Him at all costs. But there is one final qualification we are looking for. We need people who understand grace. Grace is the most important word in the Bible. Our reading today will begin with God's justified punishment of a wicked and rebellious people but it will end in a new covenant of love the people do not deserve and could never earn. That's grace!! And that grace will ultimately be fulfilled in Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection. We need the Holy Spirit to teach us about grace!

#### Things to pray about today:

- 1. God, forgive us where we have rebelled against you.
- Father, teach us what grace really means and help us understand how Your grace is the foundation of everything we believe.
- 3. Lord, raise up leaders in our church family who have a strong faith, are committed to obedience, and are full of Your grace. Strengthen the leaders we have, call out leaders from our church family, and bring us 5 new families who are ready to invest in the work You're doing in forest Park.
